319h Nonpoint Source Program

Grants available through the Clean Water Act to reduce nonpoint source pollution in priority watersheds.

- Eligibility: State and local government entities in designated priority watersheds.
- Project Types & Funding: Planning: Design: Construction: Monitoring & Analysis | \$50 >500K

Bay Restoration Fund

Grants funded through various sources for wastewater, septic, and stormwater capital upgrades.

- Eligibility: State & local governments, private entities.
- Project Types & Funding: WWTP Upgrades: Sewer Extensions; Septic BAT; Stormwater | \$Variable

Water Quality Revolving Loan Fund

Low interest financing available for wastewater treatment plant upgrades and stormwater projects.

- Eligibility: Local governments and private entities depending on the project.
- Project Types & Funding: Wastewater Treatment (Local Government only); Stormwater [\$Variable

Watershed Assistance Grant Program

Grants for project design to be used by local governments in support of county Two-year Milestones.

- Eligibility: Local governments funding projects in counties that submitted 2yr-Milestones to MDE.
- Project Types & Funding: Project design; Programmatic project support | \$5K >100K
